## FIREBIRD

Supplies: Feathers: either a bag of various size feathers, Michaels, or a 24 pc. bag of feather plumes from Walmart, have to cut down to size, but they look nice.

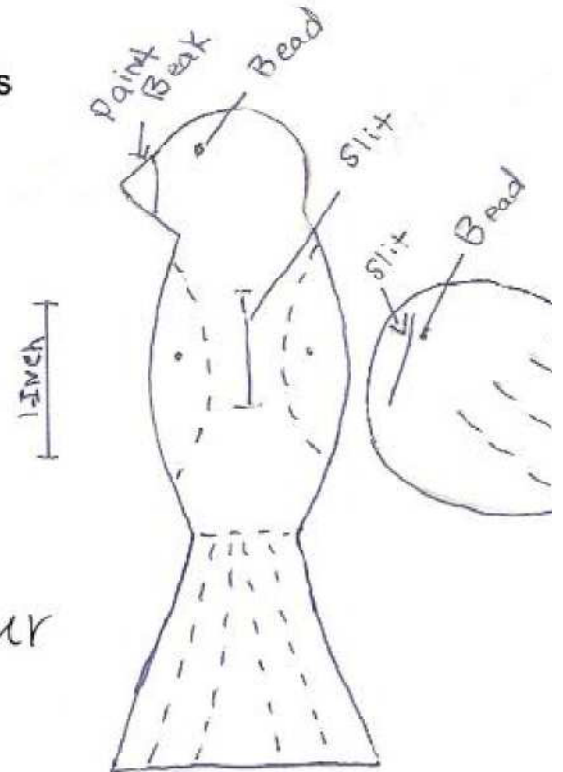
Glitter felt (Walmart) one piece will make two birds

4 seed beads, 2 for the eyes and 2 for the wings.

hand sewing needle and thread- gold acrylic paint for beak, fiberfil, craft glue, 3-D paint (Scribbles) iridescent gold and a pin back

Sew one bird and two wings on doubled felt, make a slit in or each wing section and in one side of the body. Turn RSO, sew on wings. Machine stitch the lines to the tail and wing section birds body and sew opening shut. Sew the wings to the body beads for joining. Spread a layer of glue over the tail and press into the glue, Do the same for the wings and top of head. Let dry. Add three stripes of 3-d paint over the tips of the feathers. Let dry. Add beads to the head for eyes and paint the beak. Sew the pin to the stitched opening..
