Dear Friends,,

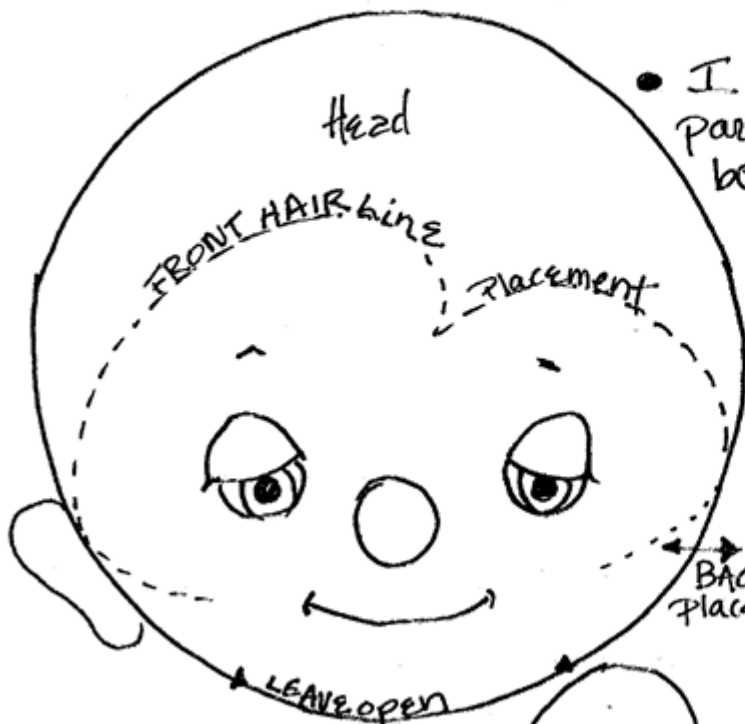
I hope you enjoy this treat

If you make her for a child in your life please be mindful of safety in your construction techniques. I made my doll from felted wool fabric but you could use felt or any fabric!

Folly Pig Tail Granddaughter Doll

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- I used felted wool fabric for all parts except the legs which were a beautiful felted "ugh" fairisle sweater

- Add seam allowance to all pieces except hair line edges + top of legs. I added 1/4"

- Stitch + Turn parts through marked openings.

EAR
cut 4

cut 1
REVERSED
FOR
Back

cut 1
This side
FOR
Front

Hand
cut 4

stuff pig tails firmly - place over head

Front Hair edge

hair/pigtails

- stuff head firmly and slide stuffed dress/body tab into the head. Add more stuffing where needed and stitch closed

Join wrist to arm then stitch the whole arm + hand. Turn!

BACK Hair edge

stitch, clip curves and Turn hair/pigtails. Stuff pig tails firmly, slide like cap onto head →

→ Embroider or glue hair edge in place on head

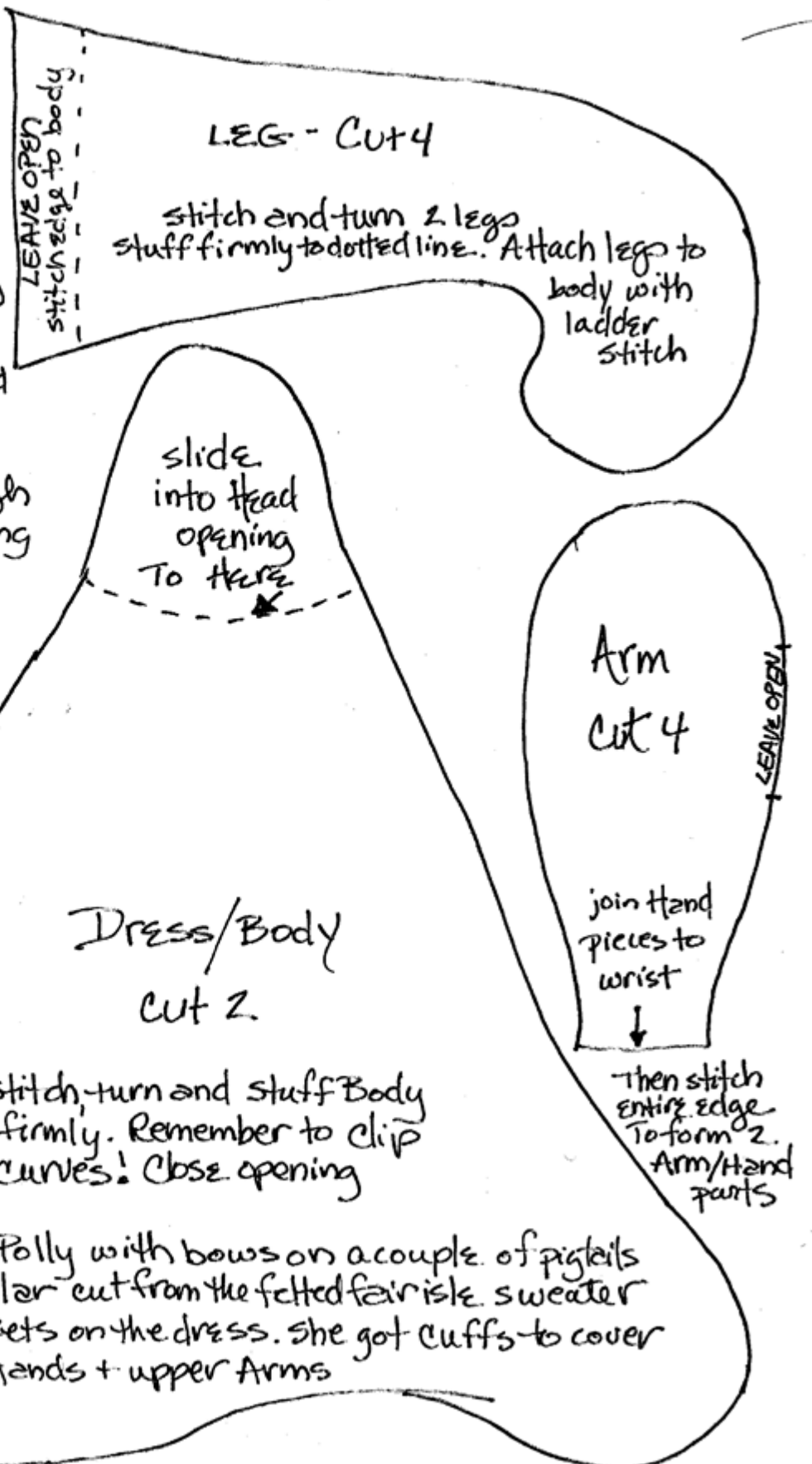
- I needle-felted the face. You could paint or embroider or use buttons (sewn on firmly)

- Ladder stitch stuffed legs to body

- Attach Arms through upper body with strong thread and buttons

- Stitch ears to the sides of the head

- I used dry chalk + a brush to blush cheeks + nose



Dress/Body
Cut 2

stitch, turn and stuff Body firmly. Remember to clip curves! Close opening

join Hand pieces to wrist

Then stitch entire edge To form 2. Arm/Hand parts

I embellished Polly with bows on a couple of pigtails
I gave her a collar cut from the felted fairisle sweater along with pockets on the dress. She got cuffs to cover join between hands + upper Arms
